## NEW YORK LAWYER SPEAKS WITH RTIP STUDENTS ON CURRENT LEGAL ISSUES



**Tucson, AZ** — Andrew Turro, a partner in the law firm Meyer, Suozzi, English & Klein, P.C., spoke to students in the Joe Hirsch Speaker Series and again in the Advanced Racing Law Class. In his first lecture he explained how he decided to pursue law, started in the racing industry and his role working with horsemen on legal issues.

In the Advanced Racing Law Class he went into more detail on numerous law cases and issues facing the industry right now. Those included out of competition drug testing, video lottery terminals, due process cases, and privacy issues. He brought up current cases as well

as older cases to show the real life application of these laws and how they affect different individuals in the industry. Students also learned how different courts operate.
