

## RTIP SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY: TURF PUBLICISTS OF AMERICA

Each year the Turf Publicists of America (TPA) awards a **\$2,000 scholarship** to a current University of Arizona Race Track Industry Program (RTIP) student with a strong record of academic achievement and a serious interest in journalism or publicity.

The successful applicant will have the opportunity to meet the TPA officers (Wendy Davis, ROAP; Claire Crawford, Del Mar Thoroughbred Club; Najja Thompson, NYTB; Ryan Martin, NYRA; Dave Zenner, Colonial Downs) and work with them on projects such as the website, membership directory, etc. This is a great opportunity to work with a racing organization while still in school.

## To Apply

Eligible students must:

- Submit a minimum 500-word essay on the following topic:
  "Why I am pursuing a career in the promotion of Thoroughbred racing."
- Include a current transcript that includes all university coursework.
- E-mail the submission packet to Dave Zenner (davezenner@gmail.com) no later than Nov. 1, 2022

The winner will be selected by the officers of the TPA after consultation with the RTIP faculty and announced during the **2022 Global Symposium on Racing** at the Loews Ventana Canyon Resort in Tucson, Ariz.

The successful scholarship recipient will have the funds applied to their Spring 2023 tuition.
